### Department of Public Safety

As we move into the coming spring season, it is important to remind our citizens of the need to be observant and diligent in securing property and locking their homes. Garden tools and power machines are ripe picking for theft when left out unattended. Keys in vehicles with the windows rolled down and unlocked, and more children on the streets due to summer vacation all pose hazards if we as citizens do not stay alert and mindful of the surrounding we live in and many times take for granted. Also, please be observant of your neighborhoods and call our department when suspicious circumstances present themselves.

Your department of public safety is committed to the safety and security of our citizens. The new nature park will provide a wonderful place for you and your families to get outside and enjoy the summer. As you enjoy the park you will notice extra patrol by our officers on 4-wheelers in an attempt to make the park as safe as possible. We would encourage skateboarders to keep in mind that skateboarding on the walking paths is prohibited and no motorized vehicles are allowed other than those authorized by the City and the Department of Public Safety.

Our department is also applying for a grant to provide a drug collection and disposal program at the city offices on the public safety side. There will be a receptacle for individuals to dispose of old prescription drugs, syringes, and any other drugs that need to be disposed of. There will be no questions ask on any of the drugs and they will be disposed of in a proper, lawful, and safe manner by the police department. More information on this program will be forthcoming.

We have recently completed the City Emergency Operations Plan and through grants have been able to develop our Emergency Operations Center located at the main City offices. Public safety is confident that should it become necessary to activate the center for any reason, we have the resources in our city and through inter-local agreements to handle those emergencies that may arise.

The Department of Public Safety has several safety and fire programs that are operated each year. We encourage our citizens to take advantage of these programs at any time and to become more familiar with issues that may affect your families. Such programs as the internet awareness program, bicycle safety, fire safety, citizen's academy, and many others, are at your disposal. We would also encourage citizens to utilize our trained personnel for speaking engagements and demonstrations for you civic, church, and neighborhood activities.

## Storm Drain Regulations

Spring is on its way. Please be aware of South Ogden City's Storm Drain Regulations.

No chemicals should be poured into the storm drain system (gutters, storm boxes, etc.) because these empty into drainage fields and streams, which then go into the rivers and water supplies in this area. Chemicals pollute the ground and/or water supplies, harming the environment and habitat.

When washing your vehicles or other items outside, use environmentally friendly, biodegradable soaps.

When using pesticides or garden products also use environmentally friendly products. Use garden products (fertilizers, etc.) as directed so no over spray will wash down the gutters. Too much spray will kill your lawn.

Any one dumping into the gutters or storm drain system will open themselves up to criminal prosecution as well as civil action obligating them for all costs in the cleanup of all the areas it may affect downstream. Please notify South Ogden Public Works Department at 622-2900 if someone is dumping anything into gutters or storm drains.
